Prime Minister is chief executive under the interim constitution act 1974. Azad Kashmir is only a part of the entire State, which is a disputed territory. So a permanent act do not exist and government of AJK runs its affairs under Interim Constitution Act 1974. President is constitutional head under this interim act, which was made in 1974. Besides Executive and legislatures an independent Judiciary is present. Total area of the State of Jammu and Kashmir is 84471 square miles. Azad Kashmir's total area is only 13297 square kilometer and population is about 4 million.
